Navigation is the first course in the sequence on navigation, covering the basics of coastal and inland navigation. It focuses on navigation with a GPS as well as traditional charting methods, enabling boaters to find their way even when the GPS fails (and it will!). Also covered: interpreting charts, navigation aids, plotting courses, determining direction and distance, using mariner's compass, planning safe courses, monitoring progress, and determining position.
