Join Maggie Dimock, Greenwich Historical Society Curator of Exhibitions and Collections, for an illustrated lecture on renowned American Impressionist Childe Hassam and his ties to Cos Cob. Learn about the thriving art colony that grew around the 18<sup>th</sup> century boardinghouse run by the Holley Family and delve into the story behind one of Hassam's earliest paintings, *The Red Mill, Cos Cob*.

*The Red Mill, Cos Cob* depicts the distinctive red-painted buildings of the Palmer & Duff shipyard, where beginning in 1858 many of the fastest and best-known wooden sloops and schooners to sail on the Long Island Sound were built. Hassam was one of many artists over the years to paint the distinctive shipyard, which proved a fascinating subject for those attracted to the old-fashioned maritime traditions of Cos Cob's Lower Landing.
